THE CELEBRATION OF BAPTISM AND PROFESSION OF FAITH

THE PRESENTATION

Liz Witjkamp, a representative of the church, will introduce the candidate for baptism.

Liz: On behalf of the congregation of Westminster United Church, I present Mark Thomas Walker for initiation into the body of Christ through profession of faith and baptism.

THE TEACHING "The Sacrament of Baptism"

The sacrament of baptism proclaims and celebrates the grace of God.

By water and the Spirit, we are called, claimed and commissioned: we are called God's own, welcomed as children of God;

we are claimed by Christ, united with Christ, with one another and the Christian community of every time and place;

we are commissioned to Christ's ministry of love, peace and justice, and strengthened by the Holy Spirit for the work of the church in the world.

PROFESSION OF FAITH AND PROMISES

Mark, I ask you these questions so you may publically profess your faith.

Do you believe in God, Source of love; in Jesus Christ, love incarnate; and in the Holy Spirit, love's power?

Candidate responds:

I DO, BY THE GRACE OF GOD.

Will you follow in the way of Jesus Christ, resisting oppression and evil, seeking justice, and witnessing to God's love for all creation?

Candidate responds:

I WILL, GOD BEING MY HELPER.

Will you follow in the way of Jesus Christ and join with your brothers and sisters in this community of faith to celebrate God's presence, live with respect in creation, and love and serve others?

Candidate responds:

I WILL, GOD BEING MY HELPER.

CONGREGATIONAL COMMITMENT (stand as you are able)

Let us pledge to Mark our support and care:

MARK, AS A BAPTIZED AND BAPTIZING PEOPLE, WE COMMIT OURSELVES TO SUPPORT AND UPHOLD YOU WITHIN THE COMMUNITY OF FAITH.

May God grant us all the grace to live our baptism.

AFFIRMATION OF FAITH, A NEW CREED (VU 918)

We are not alone; we live in God's world.
We believe in God: who has created and is creating, who has come in Jesus, the Word made flesh, to reconcile and make new, who works in us and others by the Spirit.

We trust in God.

We are called to be the Church:

to celebrate God's presence,

to live with respect in Creation,

to proclaim Jesus, crucified and risen,

our judge and our hope.

In life, in death, in life beyond death, God is with us.

We are not alone.

Thanks be to God. Amen.
